Puff Up is the Annual Catholic Retreat designed for Cub Scouts, Siblings, Parents, and their extended families:

- Scheduled Activities on Saturday – beginning at 8:30 AM and culminating with Mass at 4:30 PM
- Games, crafts, and activities are planned for the participants
- Family Camping on Friday and Saturday nights at no additional event expense
- Fees are \$10 per person – Scouts, Siblings, Parents, & Extended Family are welcome
- Annual Health and Medical Form (parts A and B) is required for all attendees
- A great daytime activity if you are unable to camp or only have Saturday open on your family calendar
- Meals are not included in the \$10/person fee

Each Unit will be assigned a campsite which includes:

- Plenty of flat ground to pitch your tent
- Access to warm showers
- Access to flush toilets
- Picnic tables
- Running water
- Ample parking
- Large covered shelter
- Campfire ring

- Temperatures should be moderate in October (check the weather as you are packing)
- Plan your own meals for the duration of your stay
- Saturday's breakfast and lunch should be quick to prepare. Lunch is suggested to be no-cook as the time will be limited
- There will be ample time on Saturday evening to prepare a full meal
- Bring comfortable, closed-toed walking shoes
- Leave all fireworks, pets, fire arms, alcohol, controlled substances, and liquid fuels at home
- Do intend on having a good time and camping with your friends and family
- You do not have to be Catholic to attend the retreat
