

# Annual Catholic Scout Retreat

## October 3 – 5, 2014 – Camp Strake, Conroe, Texas

- The Catholic Scout Retreat is an opportunity for scouts and scouters of troops and crews sponsored by Catholic Churches and Organizations in the Arch-Diocese of Galveston-Houston to gather for a weekend of fellowship.
- All Catholic Scouts working towards their religious awards have the opportunity to participate in retreat activities during the weekend and a retreat is required to earn the Ad Altare Dei and Pope Pius XII religious awards.
- The retreat is open to Scouts and Scouters of all faiths since many of the activities are non-denominational and highlight that a “Scout is Reverent”
  - Religious award counselor training for adults
  - Sessions for scouts working toward their religious awards
  - General sessions on a Scout is Reverent
  - Camporee style activities and games for the Scouts
  - Meals are provided by the retreat staff
  - Camping and a closing campfire (**one of last opportunities at Camp Strake**)
  - Coordinated with Cub Scout Puff-Up
  - Outdoor Catholic Mass for Puff-Up and Scout Retreat Participants
